


LITTLE BROWN BAT

WHY BAT BOXES?

Artificial housing provides habitats to bats that may have been displaced or disrupted. Boxes protect bats from predators and allow them to provide ecosystem services like pest control, pollination, and seed-dispersal. This also keeps bats away from places we don't want them like attics and porches!

WHERE TO MOUNT BOXES

- Areas with 6-8 hrs of direct sunlight (East or South facing)
- 20-30 ft away from obstacles like tree branches
- 12-20 feet from the ground
